ORDINANCE NO. 483

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 90 (ANIMALS) AND CHAPTER 55 (PARKS, TRAILS AND OPEN SPACE) OF THE MORA CITY CODE TO INCLUDE REGULATIONS AT AN OFF-LEASH DOG PARK

THE CITY OF MORA, KANABEC COUNTY, MINNESOTA ORDAINS:

Section 1. That section 90.02(A) (Regulations) of Chapter 90 of the Mora City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

(A) Running at large prohibited. [#] Except within the designated area at the city's off-leash dog park, it shall be unlawful for the dog or cat of any person who owns, harbors or keeps a dog or cat, to run at large. A person, who owns, harbors or keeps a dog or cat which runs at large shall be guilty of a misdemeanor. Dogs or cats on a leash and accompanied by a responsible person or accompanied by and under the control and direction of a responsible person, so as to be effectively restrained by command as by leash, shall be permitted in streets or on public land unless the city has posted an area with signs reading "Dogs or Cats Prohibited."

Section 2. That Section 55.02(J) of Chapter 55 of the Mora City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

(J) [No] Except within the designated area at the city's off-leash dog park, no dogs shall be allowed in any park except on a leash and under the control of its owner.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and publication.
