Community Health

1. Oath of Office. Jenna Fore pledged the oath of office for a three-year term expiring on December 31, 2022.

- 2. <u>Call to Order.</u> Chair Brockner called the meeting to order via a public Webex virtual meeting at 6:00 p.m.
- 3. Roll Call. All board members were present except Mickey Kringstad with Kringstad arriving later as noted below.
- 4. Adopt Agenda. Mathison asked to amend the Agenda to include Arts in the Park which was added to #9. Motion by Mathison, second by Hosley to approve the June 9, 2020 meeting agenda as amended. All present voted aye. Motion carried.
- 5. <u>Minutes.</u> Motion by Mathison, second by Hosley to approve the May 5, 2020 meeting minutes as presented. All present voted aye. Motion carried.
- 6. Summer Recreation. *Kringstad joined meeting. Krie discussed that staff was looking to come up with some summer events for children to enjoy and presented board with some ideas of his own and of Patti Miller. Staff also reached out earlier to Miller to see if she would like to partner with the City and to share her ideas with the Park Board. Krie then turned the meeting over to Miller to share her ideas. Miller went over her experience with SACK and the success in doing community events for children. Miller shared how working with various community partners help with SACK's success and provided some of her resources. Park Board had a great discussion regarding what was presented and many ideas where shared. Hosley and Brockner both supported also looking into adult events to help provide activities and social interaction due to isolation during COVID times. Kringstad suggested activities that could allow for social distancing and that people could do on their own time at their own comfort level. Mathison cautioned social distancing guidelines if we use Movie in the Park. All agreed to move forward with the project and would supplement any other ideas to Krie.

- 7. Music in the Park. Krie updated the Park Board on where it stands regarding Music in the Park and that a band opted out due to COVID-19 concerns. Another band was found and replaced into the event date. Krie ask Board for ideas regarding COVID-19 concerns to promote safety for performers and attendees. Board then shared and discussed ideas on concerns due to COVID. Hosley suggested to mark off spaces and to follow CDC guidelines for events. Brockner suggested extra signing to promote social distancing.
- 8. Fall Fest. Krie brought up to Park Board on where they stood on whether to host Fall Fest for 2020 or to cancel event due to COVID-19 concerns and to forward that information to staff. While ultimately this will be a City Council decision the Board was in an agreement that they felt it was too early to cancel the event and that we should give it more time. At this time Board agreed that Fall Fest should go forward at this time. Discussion then took place on what events were still social distancing friendly. All agreed more staff would be needed at all stations. Mathison suggested and all agreed that we could modify event if needed to fit where the state was regarding COVID-19 restrictions and to still provide some entertainment for the community. More discussion on COVID concerns will be discussed in the upcoming meetings regarding Fall Fest.
- 9. Arts in the Park. Mathison brought up to the Board the idea of having some form of Arts in the Park. Funding could come from ECRAC grants. Mathison idea is to promote Art in our Parks and or Trails in one form or another. One idea that was presented was with the passing of Neil Rabens who was the co-creator of the classic board game Twister to contact a local artist to create something in his honor. All agreed that this was something the Park Board supports.

10. Project Updates.

Kohlgraf reported to the board the following.

- Parks are up and running:
- Ténnis/Pickleball courts are awaiting repainting and that would happen after the vendor completed the school's courts.

Krie reported to the board the following.

- MAC building received a new coat of paint.
- Slide restoration would be presented to the Council for approval.
- Other maintenance was being completed on the MAC awaiting vendor.
- There have been some rentals for the Library Park Shelter, Gazebo and Jaycee Ball Fields.
