1. Call to Order. Vice Chair Kringstad called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.
2. Roll Call.
 - Brockner – Absent excused
 - Fore – *Fore arrived at 6:02pm
 - Hosley – Present

 - Mathison - Present
3. Adopt Agenda. Motion by Mathison, second by Hosley to approve the October 10, 2020 meeting agenda. All present voted aye. Motion carried.
4. Minutes. Motion by Mathison, second by Hosley to approve the September 8, 2020 meeting minutes as presented. All present voted aye. Motion carried.
5. Fall Fest. The Board recapped September 26, 2020 Fall Fest. All agreed it was the best result we could hope for with what we had to work with during COVID-19 times and the weather which was cloudy all day and drizzly after 2pm. Overall positive comments from attendees and it was nice to see families out enjoying the event. All felt the turnout was good. The activities we could provide for Fall Fest were very popular Cone Maze (instead of Hay Bale Maze due to rain), Speed Zone, Pumpkin Painting (Coburns went through 200 pumpkins; they were well prepared), Pickle Ball, and the Dunk Tank having the most participants. Kohlgraf wanted to know how Cone Maze went since there was a chance of rain and we could not do the Hay Maze, the consensus was that it worked well and was used. Food vendors were not as busy as they hoped. Mr D.s arrived late and took to long to prepare food. KTown might not have the best menu for this type of event. Discussion turned to getting some vendors with variety and more Fair type food. Mathison suggested we look and discuss next year on whether to cut down on the time frame at Fall Fest as in both years it was quiet the last hour. The discussion turned to entertainment in that the Juggler and Magician had good attendance but the Will Hale musician had little following. Krie discussed to move the Band first with Juggler second, and Magician third. Hosley shared that the Park Board table with information went well and that it was nice to see some new residents looking over the information. Kringstad asked if the brochure could be shared. Krie stated he would look to see it can be put on City website or Facebook. It was

suggested if we could have a Wine Vendor be present at the event. Concern from the board was if the community would be comfortable with liquor at this type of event and if the City would endorse that type of vendor. It was suggested not to close the door on the idea and more information would be needed. Hosley commented it was good to see the Sheriff's reserve at Fall Fest. All are looking forward to a more normal Fall Fest event in 2021.

6. Project Updates.

Kohlgraf reported to the board the following.

- Parks mulched and continuing leaf cleaning.
- Lions bathrooms is closed for the season.
- The restroom at Library Park will be pulled at the end of the month.
- Parks will stay open till end of October.
- Still pushing to get Kids Kingdom and Library Park Gazebo sealed.

Krie reported to the board the following.

- With the help of Joe and his staff the kiddie pool was painted.
- Other odds and ends and maintenance will continue at the MAC.
- Another good season for Music in the Park. Late September concerts had smaller attendance. Very positive comments during the season by the surveys given.

Hosley reported to the board the following.

- The dog park group will be contacting Krie in the upcoming months about where they are and what they need to do. They continue to get donations and are well organized.

Mathison reported to the board the following.

- Since COVID put everything on hold Mathison would still like to look into a getting a Twister Art installation at one of the parks if possible.

7. Adjournment. Motion by Hosley, second by Fore to adjourn the meeting. All present voted aye. Meeting adjourned at 6:25 p.m.
